SCOTTISH GALVANIZERS REACH NEW HEIGHTS

wan Lawrie, a metalworker and sculptor from Fort William, was commissioned by Nevis Range Ski Centre to create a bespoke sculpture of an eagle to stand proudly outside of its newlyconstructed hotel in Fort William. He enlisted local businesses, MacPherson Welding & Engineering Services Ltd, and Scottish Galvanizers, to support the project.

Ewan said, "Having used timber previously - which looked brilliant to begin with but weathered easily - I now work exclusively with steel to enhance

longevity. I've worked with Scottish Galvanizers on a previous project, so was keen to enlist their help yet again to ensure my latest piece would be protected for 70+ years.

"Due to the planned location of the bird, exposed to the harsh highland weather conditions including frequent snow and ice, I knew that a hot-dip galvanized finish would provide the most suitable protection."

The sculpture, constructed from 5mm steel, took four months to complete and used 500kg of steel.

erseyside Galvanizing had a Mittle help from their friends at Diamond Precision Engineering with their latest project. Last year, Paul McCartney celebrated his 80th birthday and The Beatles Story Museum at Albert Dock, alongside Hofner Guitars, commissioned a sculpture to commemorate his illustrious six-decade career.

The guitar, which measures a staggering 4 metres long and 3 metres high, pays homage to the iconic scouse band and takes pride of place in Liverpool City Centre.

Oliver Pitt, Director at Diamond Precision Engineering, says: "Both the guitar and panels surrounding it are made from 6mm mild steel. which we laser cut and secured to a box section frame. We then sent it over to the team at Merseyside Galvanizing to protect it from the elements, before it was powder coated and wrapped in vinyl logos."



GALVANIZING PROVIDES LONG-TERM PROTECTION AT UK'S BUSIEST MARINA

Wessex Galvanizers was called upon by steel fabricators ML (UK) to provide its hot-dip galvanizing treatment to 121 tonnes of steel, which has been used to support an existing structure forming the main sea defence at Brighton Marina.

The existing concrete structure was showing signs of deterioration and ML (UK)'s strengthening work, delivered as part of a major development at the marina, will provide ongoing stability required to maintain the breakwater's in what is often a hostile and corrosive environment.

Graham Ferguson, Engineering Manager at ML (UK), explained: "This has been a huge reinvestment to ensure the longevity and structural integrity at Brighton Marina, the UK's largest marina and one of the most popular harbours for yachts and motorboats.

"We called on the team at Wessex Galvanizers to process over 120 tonnes of steel.

The major steel components - including the chassis, bulkhead and axles - are acid dipped at local business, Surface Processing in Dudley, before Edward Howell Galvanizers collect and galvanize them.

"Jim and the team take great care when galvanizing to prevent the thin steel from buckling, and this precision and attention to detail is really appreciated," Rob continued. "But my latest project consists of parts that are too small as they need hanging. Luckily, another galvanizing plant in the Wedge family, B.E. Wedge, specialises in smaller centrifuge galvanizing and was able to help".

fter months of developments, we're Apleased to finally see the results of major investments at our Wessex and Manchester plants, which ensure they're fit for the future.



rtist blacksmith, and longtime customer of Humber Galvanizing, Katie Ventress, has sought their support to galvanize two fantastic animal sculptures.

The first, which was funded by charitable donations, York Housing Association and Karbon Homes, was a sculpture of a Humpback whale tail. Standing at 1.8m tall

and approx. 1.73m wide, it was constructed using an internal steel skeleton to form the shape and strength, with 2mm panels of sheet steel then welded to it to replicate the whale's skin.

The second was a baboon garden sculpture, commissioned by a customer who previously lived in Africa.
